Bronzing and metal powders	4d. lb. (now free all tariffs).
Agricultural implements	EP (now General).
Timber 12" x 10" and over	Extend to 12" x 6" and over.
x Box timber 4" x 3" and over	Remove size restriction. Increase from 1s. to 2s. per 100 super. ft.
x Box timber (shooks)	Consolidate items. Increase from 2s. to 4s. per 100 super.ft.
Rubber footwear	EP (now Intermediate and General).
Elastic, boot and apparel	10% ad val. (now free all tariffs).
Rubber tires and tubes	EP (now General).
Pulp for paper making	£2 ton (now free all tariffs).
Newsprint	Suggest specific instead of ad. val. primage (free EP).
Wrapping papers	EP (now General).
Fruit wraps	Make Free - £3 ton Gen. (now free all tariffs); limit drawback to 75%.
Advertising matter	EP now equivalent 77½%; reduction suggested
Unassembled motor car chassis	EP (now Intermediate).
Assembled motor car chassis	EP (now Intermediate).
Motor car body panels	EP (now General).
Motor car gears	EP (now General).
Shock absorbers	EP (now General).
Piano keyboards and other piano parts	EP(now General).
Tobaccos	Preference of 6d. to 3s. 1b.(EP now same as General all classes.)
