

Salaries.

5. The Trustees shall be paid by the National Company such salaries as may from time to time be fixed by the Governor in Council, and if any Trustee is in receipt of a pension from any railway company he shall not be entitled to receive or to be paid such pension during his term of office.

Pensions.

One salary only to each Trustee.

(2) Each Trustee shall be paid but one salary, and saving and excepting that and his right to prepayment or repayment of his proper expenditures made while engaged in and upon the affairs of National Railways, he shall not be 10 entitled upon any ground to any recompense or emolument.
