Sir,--

The Indian Agent has reported that he sent the constable to warn persons cutting timber on Caughnawaga Reserve and removing it without authority prior to the division of the estate in which you claim to have an interest, and that they ceased for a time and began cutting again afterwards under the pretext that they were only taking their shares as you had taken your share without consulting the other heirs, and without wishing to make the division.

He also reported that if you have not had your share, as you claim, you have your recourse against the parties, as the timber has all disappeared.
