

even to an Indian of the Band without the consent and approval of the Superintendent General to be given in the manner provided by Section 19 of the Indian Act 1880 and by Section 5 of the Act 47 Vic. Cap. 27. If the Location should undertake to devise by will, the latter would require the assent of the Band and the approval of the Superintendent General before it would be valid, and no subsequent Claimant would be legally in possession until he or she had received a Location Ticket from the Superintendent General; and in consideration of these facts, and as the Indians do not ^{desire to} deprive the present occupants of the right.
