

even to an Indian of the Band
 without the consent and appro-
 -val of the Superintendent General
 to be given in the manner pro-
 -vided by Section 19 of the Indian
 Act 1880 and by Section 5 of the
 Act 47 Vic. Cap. 27. If the Location
 should undertake to devise by
 will, the latter would require the
 assent of the Band and the
 approval of the Superintendent
 General before it would be valid,
 and no subsequent Claimant
 would be legally in possession
 until he or she had received a
 Location Ticket from the Super-
 -intendent General; and in
 consideration of these facts, and
 as the Indians do not ^{desire to} deprive
 the present occupants of the right.
