In view of this opinion, I shall at once communicate with the Indian Commissioner at Regina for the N.W.S. requesting him in future to order any vaccine that he may require for the Indians within his Superintendency from you, and I shall also do the same as regards the Indian Superintendent at Winnipeg, Man. and the Indian Superintendent at Victoria, B.C. Any orders for vaccine for the Indians of the older Provinces will be forwarded to
