
Ottawa, December 4, 1906.

My Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th ult., stating that a new head is required for the windmill at your school; that a new pump is needed for the well at the barn and that it is necessary that a metallic ceiling be placed in the Junior school-room, the total estimated cost of which is given at \$222, and asking permission to make these repairs out of the grant of \$600 provided for repairs to your school.

In reply I beg to say that, in view of your explanations, you may have these repairs made, the accounts for which will be paid out of the grant above referred to.
