I beg to inform you that the Department has received several complaints with regard to the bacon which you have supplied under contract. Some of it has been reported to be so tainted as to be unfit for use, in other cases it has been necessary to have it re salted. No such complaints were received in past years with regard to bacon supplied by other contractors. The Department was therefore forced to the conclusion that the bacon furnished this year by your firm was not sufficiently cured. It is hoped that the November shipment will be in every respect up to the standard.
