Gentlemen,-

Referring to your letter of the 27th ultimo, I return herewith Renewal Receipt which you forwarded in connection with the bonding by The Imperial Guarantee & Accident Insurance Co. of Canada of certain officers belonging to this Department.


I enclose herewith an official list of officers of this Department, guaranteed under Bond No. 02205, renewed April 1st, 1915. You will observe that the following changes have been made in the list of officers which you forwarded with letter above referred to, viz:-

Mr. J. Blain of Montreal died on the 3rd January, 1915, and the Asst. Agent, Mr. J. Brosseau, of St. Constant, who is bonded for \$2,000.00, succeeded him in office. Therefore, Mr. Blain's name no longer appears on the official list covered by the bond.

Mr. R. A. Irving, of Buctouche, N. B. died on the 18th November, 1914, and was succeeded in office by Mr. Geo. A. Hutchinson. Mr. Hutchinson should be bonded at the same rate as his predecessor.
