

AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT made this 2^d day of April
A.D. 1942 between Seymour Grant Indian of the
Musqueam Band, of the first part, and Joe Too
whose city address is: 546 Shanghai Alley, Vancouver, B. C.

WITNESSETH that the party of the first part shall surrender to the Indian Affairs Branch a portion of Lacsquerm Indian Reserve No.2, amounting to -----Five ----- acres, more or less, for the purpose of the granting by the Indian Affairs Branch to the said party of the second part a permit to occupy and cultivate the said portion of Lacsquerm Indian Reserve for a period of one year from January 1st 1942 to December 31st 1942 on a rental to be paid by the party of the second part to the Indian Affairs Branch, on behalf of the party of the first part, amounting to:

-----One Hundred & Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00) per an.
subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The party of the second part shall pay rental at the office of the Indian Agent, 416 Federal Building, Vancouver, B. C. ONLY as follows:

87.50 or before April 1st 1942
" 87.50 " Oct. 1st 1942

2. It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that no payments of rental are to be made direct to the party of the first part, and that 8% interest may be charged on overdue rentals.

3. The party of the second part agrees with the party of the first part and the Indian Affairs Branch that he will keep the said premises in clean, sanitary condition; and that should he neglect to do so, the Indian Agent shall cause the said premises to be placed in sanitary condition at the expense of the party of the second part.

4. The party of the second part further agrees that he will not
use any timber upon said Reserve or other purposes on any portion of
the said Reserve without the sanction of the Indian Agent; that
he will not take intoxicants of any kind on to the said Reserve or
portion of Reserve, and that he will keep the peace within the said
Reserve, and comply with all the rules and regulations governing
Indians Reserve.

5. The party of the second part agrees also that he will not require from the party of the first part or the Indian Agent any notice to vacate the said Reserve upon the expiration of this permit, and that he will be willing to vacate the land if required to do so at the expiration of the said permit without any notice of any kind whatever.
