December 11th., 1940.

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Comox Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at Comox, in the Cowichan Indian Agency, in the Province of B. C. at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 11th. day of December, A.D. 1940., in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of the said Reserve, request ~~that the same be approved of~~

~~that the same be approved of~~ that approval by the Indian Affairs Branch, Dept. of Mines & Resources, be given to the Amalgamation of the Comox Band, in the Cowichan Indian Agency with the Salmon River Band in the Alert Bay Agency, and that all Reserves, Band funds and other Band property be amalgamated and made the property of the entire membership.

That all other provisions mentioned in our Resolution dated September 13th. 1940. be approved of.
