Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 17<sup>th</sup> inst with a copy of communication from Mr. Bryan Williams Esq J.P. Provincial Game Warden enclosed

In reply would say that I am taking every means possible to communicate to the Indians throughout this Agency the substance of the Game Act and regulations governing the close season and the fact that Indians may obtain a permit to kill <sup>male</sup> deer over one year old at any season of the year for food only.

Apparently the reason why the receipt of the Game Act was not acknowledged was because it reached this office during my absence and no messenger accompanied it.
