

for his own benefit or advancement, all the expenses of the meeting shall be defrayed by him.

IV.—ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

The elective Officers of this Lodge shall be annually elected at the Regular Meeting, immediately preceding the Festival of St. John the Evangelist, and on the day of that Festival, (or should it fall on a Sunday, then on the following day,) the election of the Master being first confirmed, all the Officers, elective and appointed, shall be installed and invested.

V.—REGULARITY OF ATTENDANCE.

To secure that regularity so highly necessary for the good government of a Lodge, it is expected that every Officer will attend punctually at the hour named in the Summons, under penalty of censure by the Master, unless exonerated by some reasonable excuse or cause of absence.

VI.—CLOTHING.

Brethren shall at all times appear, when in Lodge, in the proper Masonic Clothing, as prescribed by the Book of Constitution.

VII.—DISCUSSION.

Every Brother, when speaking, shall address himself to the Master; and no Brother shall speak twice to the same question, unless in explanation, or the mover in reply. No motion shall be entertained unless it be made in writing and duly seconded. No new business shall be entered upon after eleven o'clock at night.
