

SPECIAL NOTICE.

Parties ordering Books to be sent *by mail*, will bear in mind that, according to law, the postage requires to be **PRE-PAID**, at *one cent per ounce*, which must be remitted *in addition* to the price of the books ordered. This is the cheapest mode of sending all packages under twenty-five ounces, as the Express Company will not convey a parcel (no matter how small) to the nearest station, for less than twenty-five cents. Postal communication cannot be sent with parcels by mail without subjecting the same to letter postage.

It is very important that addresses be plainly written, and explicit directions given. Persons living remote from the lines of railway, whose parcels are to be sent by Express, should give the nearest Station, in addition to the Post Office address.

The usual discount allowed to Ministers, Students, Teachers, and Sunday-schools, except on Ministers' Requisites, S. S. Requisites, Music Books, S. S. Hymn Books, and books marked "net" in Catalogue.

The prices of American books will be regulated by the rise and fall of gold.

Books suitable for our Stock, and not in this Catalogue, when obtainable, will be supplied, on due notice being given; also New Works, as soon as issued from the press.

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
