This is the best month for early forcing. Put up and prepare hot beds for cucumbers, melons, lettuces, radishes, Early York, cauliflowers. Sow a few tender annuals towards the latter end of the month, for transplanting in the open ground. Give air to greenhouse in fine weather. Sow in a sheltered situation, if the season will allow a few early peas. Begin to prune your orchard trees, but keep in mind that just before the sap commences to rise is the best season. Plant indigenous shrubs and evergreens. They must be taken up with good balls of earth attached to the roots, that the smaller fibres may be disturbed and broken as little as possible. Transplant rose trees.

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
