DEAR SIR,—I have lately built two brick churches in my parish, viz. one at Wardsville and one at Alvinston, and have yet another to build in Bothwell next summer, otherwise His Lordship the Bishop of London has declined his intention to interdict the present building on the first of March unless operations are commenced by that date.
In Bothwell there are only 32 families, in Wardsville 30 families, and in Alvinston 16 families. THE ZULU MASSACRE.

THE DISASTER OF ISANDULA—A GRAPHIC DESCRIPTION.
DEAD ZULUS CAST ON THE BRITISH BAYONETS.

From the London Daily News.
The following detailed account of the terrible disaster at Isandula is telegraphed from Malacca:—"The day before the action took place Colonel Glyn, in command of the third column, acting under the direct orders of Lord Chelmsford, sent away the advance guard under the command of Major Dartnall, composed of a detachment of carabineers, the Natal mounted police, Londsdale's native contingent and others. This advance guard sent to say it was engaged with the Zulus. Lord Chelmsford himself, with Colonel Glyn pushed forward the main force, consisting of seven companies of the 24th, under Lieutenant Colonel Degacher, Londsdale's native contingent, under Major Black, 24th and other troops, leaving behind as rear guard five companies of the 24th, under Lieutenant Colonel Bullen, one company of 24th, under Lieutenant Pope, and a portion of the First regiment of the Natal native contingent, under Lieutenant Colonel Durnford, with the following cavalry:—About thirty naval carabineers, the Buffalo Border Guard, and about twenty-five Newcastle mounted riflemen. In addition Colonel Durnford had Sikaki's Horse and two guns, under Captain Russell, Royal Artillery. There were a few artillerymen. The Army Hospital Corps, the Commissariat, with a column of Lord Chelmsford's, moved forward on the evening of the 21st of the morning of the 22nd. The rear guard had finished its usual morning march and outspanned when the Zulu skirmishers were observed surrounding the hills. These skirmishers, advanced toward the camp, keeping up a desultory fire. The camp was pitched in a broken country, in a sort of valley, with distant surrounding hills. Colonel Bullen sent skirmishers, who responded to the fire of the Zulus. It seems that the number of Zulus was not estimated, it being considered a slight demonstration of a few men. As the enemy's scouts were soon joined by bodies of considerable strength, Colonel Bullen's skirmishers were recalled, and the camp hastily put upon the defensive. The rear guard came on rapidly in regular battalions, eight deep, keeping up a heavy steady fire, until well within assegai distance. Then they ceased to fire, and hurled assegais. Our men kept up a steady fire, and great numbers of the enemy dropped, but without checking their progress. The places of the men who fell were constantly filled by comrades.
THE AMMUNITION WAGGONS CAPTURED.
While the attack was going on in the rear, a double flank movement was executed by which the horns of the Zulu army surrounded the camp. The advantage of the waggon route led to the disaster. Our men had emptied their pouches and found it impossible to replenish them, as the Zulus had obtained possession of the ammunition waggon. Our officers then became an absolute butchery. Our officers and men were assailed as they stood. The Zulus, in the weight of their battalions and literally crushed the small body, which could only defend itself with the bayonet, and very soon it had not even room to do that. The Zulus picked up the dead bodies of their comrades and hurled them on to the bayonet. The work of destruction was done by the Zulus. The waggon route, the commissariat supplies, the waggon, the oxen, the material of the column fell into the hands of the enemy. Fortunately two waggoners were spiked by Captain Smith, Royal Artillery, who was assigned while in the act of spiking.
The Zulu army was completely organized. It advanced, first throwing out skirmishers, then, as the battalions came down in mass, they were supported by long range, the favorite Indian mode of attack, by their own more familiar weapon, when near enough to use their own more familiar weapon, they threw in two or three showers. At this time they were advancing steadily and rapidly, and the stabling assegai was soon at work.
