

By Mr. Whitney,—The Petition of the *Montreal* Home and School of Industry.

Ordered, That the Petition of *Charles Sangster*, of the City of *Kingston*, be referred to the Joint Committee of both Houses for the regulation and management of the Library of Parliament.

Mr. *Turcotte*, from the Standing Committee on Standing Orders, presented to the House the Fifth Report of the said Committee; which was read, as followeth:—

Your Committee have examined the Petitions of *Charles De Witt* and others, for the settlement of the boundary line between the Seigniori of *Beauharnois*, the Township of *Godmanchester*, and the Parish of *St. Anicet*; of *Ira Gould* and others, of *Montreal*, for the incorporation of a Company to establish a Line of Steamers between the *St. Lawrence* and the Upper Lakes; of the Municipality of *Windsor*, for an Act to incorporate the said Town; of *John McCrea* and others, Trustees of *St. Andrew's Church, Guelph*; of *Calvin McQuesten* and others, Trustees of the *Hamilton Presbyterian Society*; of *Thomas R. Ferguson* and others, for an Act to require the *Ontario, Simcoe, and Huron Railroad Company* to fence their line of Road; and of *Henry R. Archer* and others, for the formation of a new County, composed of *Dunwich, Aldborough, Orford, Ekfrid, Mosa, Euphemia, Zone, Metcalfe, and Brooke*; and they find the Notice in each case sufficient.

The Petitions of the Corporation of the College of *L'Assomption*, for amendments to their Act of Incorporation; and of *Edouard Germain Paradis* and others, for an Act to legalize the proceedings of the Municipality of *St. Norbert d'Arthabaska* in regard to the appointment of Assessors, are not, in the opinion of Your Committee, of a nature to require the publication of Notice.

Ordered, That Mr. *Holton* have leave to bring in a Bill to incorporate the *Canadian Inland Steam Navigation Company*.

He accordingly presented the said Bill to the House, and the same was received and read for the first time; and ordered to be read a second time To-morrow.

Ordered, That Mr. *Fergusson* have leave to bring in a Bill to authorize the Trustees for the Congregation of *St. Andrew's Church*, in the Town of *Guelph*, adhering to the Presbyterian Church of *Canada* in connection with the Church of *Scotland*, to sell certain Lands held by them in trust for such Congregation.

He accordingly presented the said Bill to the House, and the same was received and read for the first time; and ordered to be read a second time on Thursday next.

Ordered, That Mr. *Somerville* have leave to bring in a Bill to authorize the running of the boundary line between the Seigniori of *Beauharnois*, the Township of *Godmanchester*, and the Parish of *St. Anicet*.

Ordered, That Mr. *Rhodes* have leave to bring in a Bill to incorporate the Church of *England Male Orphan Asylum at Quebec*.
