Not providing wife, child, apprentice, or servant, &e., with food, &c., whereby life is endangered. åс.

25. Whosoever, being legally liable, either as a husband parent, guardian or committee, master or mistress, nurse or other wise, to provide for any person as wife, child, ward, lunatic or idio apprentice or servant, infant or otherwise, necessary food, clothing or lodging, wilfully and without lawful excuse, refuses or neglect to provide the same, or unlawfully or maliciously does, or cause to be done, any bodily harm to any such apprentice or servant, so that the life of such apprentice or servant is endangered, or the health of such apprentice or servant has been, or is likely to be permanently injured, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall liable to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for any term not exceeding three years and not less than two years, or to imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour.

Exposing children, whereby life

26. Whosoever unlawfully abandons or exposes any child being under the age of two years, whereby the life of such child is endangered, is endangered, or the health of such child has been, or is like to be permanently injured, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and sha be liable to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for any term exceeding three years and not less than two years, or to imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour.

27. Whosoever unlawfully and maliciously, by the explosion Causing bodily injury by gun- of gunpowder or other explosive substance, burns, mains, powder, &c. figures, disables or does any grievous bodily harm to any person is guilty of felony, and shall be liable to be imprisoned in 0 Penitentiary for life, or for any term not less than two years, to be imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement any term less than two years, with or without hard labour with or without solitary confinement.

Causing gunpowder to explode, or sending to any person an explosive substance, or throwing corrosive fluid on a person with intent to do grievous bodily harm.

28. Whosoever unlawfully and maliciously causes any go powder or other explosive substance to explode, or sends delivers to, or causes to be taken or received by any person, explosive substance, or any other dangerous or noxious think or puts or lays at any place, or casts or throws at or upon, otherwise applies to any person, any corrosive fluid, or any tructive or explosive substance, with intent in any of the case aforesaid, to burn, maim, disfigure or disable any person, or to some grievous bodily harm to any person, whether any bodily harm be effected or not, is guilty of felony, and shall be to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for life, or for any term less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or p of confinement, for any term less than two years, with or with out hard labour, and with or without solitary confinement.
