Shortage of Ties Holds up Work on New Railway Line

Inability to procure sufficient supplies of railroad ties, or sleepers, is hampering merous railroads in Canada and the United States. An ordinary tie costs \$1 will exist several years. During the great war the number of ties cut fell greatly Last year there was an excessive demand for ties and the supply was soon absorbed.

The scarcity of ties has stopped construction of the proposed electric road across northern Maine from Presque Isle to the border of the province of Quebec, original contractor for the Valley road, is designed to provide a short route between Ouebec, Montreal and St. John.

It is probable that work will not be undertaken on the proposed line until next year.
