

The Premier's Health. Ottawa, June 9.—The following is the latest bulletin respecting Sir John A. Macdonald's health: "A. M.—Sir John A. Macdonald's progress has been so regular and marked during the past week as to give favorable hopes of a permanent recovery. (Signed) J. A. Grant and S. W. Campbell."

Thereupon Township Roads.—The Township of Barrie, in the County of Addington, against Messrs. Hillier & Macrae, lumber merchants of Perth for cutting timber on the land allowance of that Township. The defendants claimed the right to cut under Crown Timber Licenses, although the Township passed a by-law protecting timber. A verdict at last session was rendered for the plaintiff, \$2,500 damages. A rule was granted by the Court on motion for a non-suit of the defendants contending that the Crown Licenses protected them; that the property was in the Crown, and could not be sold with its own. The Court, however, gave judgment in favor of the Township, which entitles the Township to hold the verdict. The decision is most important as it clearly establishes the right of Township to deal with the timber on Township roads.

The Grand Trunk Workshops. We have received a copy of the following telegram through a Stratford Beacon extra addressed to the Mayor of that Town, which indicates positively that the Grand Trunk Workshops are to be removed there.

MONTREAL, June 6, 1870. T. Daly, Mayor, Stratford. Thanks for your message. You must press a resolution or by-law closing the street across the property. The building will be commenced immediately. I have sent officers along the line, asking to establish the workshops there. They offer land free from all taxation for my period we like, and in some instances special bonuses of money. My inevitable reply is that the works are located at Stratford and beyond the jurisdiction of the Grand Trunk Workshops without delay.

A Mammoth Hotel. It will have a frontage of 23 feet on State street, and 230 on Monroe. It is to be eight stories high, and will contain 100 rooms. It will be in the style of the Palace, built by Louis Philippe, and will cost, including the grounds, over \$2,500,000.
