Fattening of cattle on the elevator screenings was tried out during the past winter with gratifying results. There is practically an inexhaustible supply of the screenings at the head of the lakes, and the wintering of cattle, as well as sheep, will probably be carried on extensively next winter. There is only one drawback and that is the scarcity of hay, but this is being investigated by municipal and other city organizations with a view to relieving the situation, and making Fort William a profitable centre for winter feeding of western stock.


