

The following letter from France His lordship says that this statement has been sent home by Ermine S.

Lance-Corp. E. S. Copeland, First Canadian Contingent, British Expeditionary Force, 1st Infantry Brigade. 1st Canadian Battalion, No. 3 Co.

February 15, 1915.

Dear Mother: As I have told you, we are not far from the music, and all last night and this morning we can hear the heavy artillery booming. I guess the British are giving the Germans what they deserve. Last night Major Beattie, the brigade chaplain, held a splendid little service in our billet. It was short, but very effective. He gave us a little talk, then we sang "Nearer, My God, to Thee," and

had a short prayer. We have a great time trying to get around the French words. It is quite amusing indeed to see us trying to express ourselves. I have yet to see the country that can beat Canada. France or England (what I have seen them) cannot compare to Canada.

Officers Good to Men. I think our officers are even nicer to us now than ever they were. They try their best to make everything comfortable for us. You can understand how many inconveniences there are in a big move. It is certainly not the easiest thing to get the men their proper rations while on train, boat, or the first few days after landing. Yet our officers did wonders, and we have never yet gone hungry for very long. Of course, there are some who will complain, but they would do that if they were in a palace with a hundred servants. I really think the officers deserve great credit for their kind atten-

tion to the men's wants. Great Experience. This certainly is a great experience, and when it is all over and I am back with you all again, I will be able to tell you all kinds of stories. I feel quite confident that I am not here to stop a German bullet or be a landing place for a "Jack Johnson." Very affectionately,


