FIRST SEDERUNT.

*At Halifax, and in Poplar Grove Church,
June 27th, 1865, and at 8 o'clock, p. m.*

The Synod of the Presbyterian Church of the Lower Provinces of British North America, after a sermon by Rev. D.B. Blair, the moderator, from 2 Cor. v. 20th—"Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech *you* by us: we pray *you* in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God,"—met and was constituted.

The PRESBYTERY OF PICTOU reported—

That the Rev. Angus McGillivray had demitted his charge of the congregation of Springville, and that his name had been removed in consequence from their roll.
