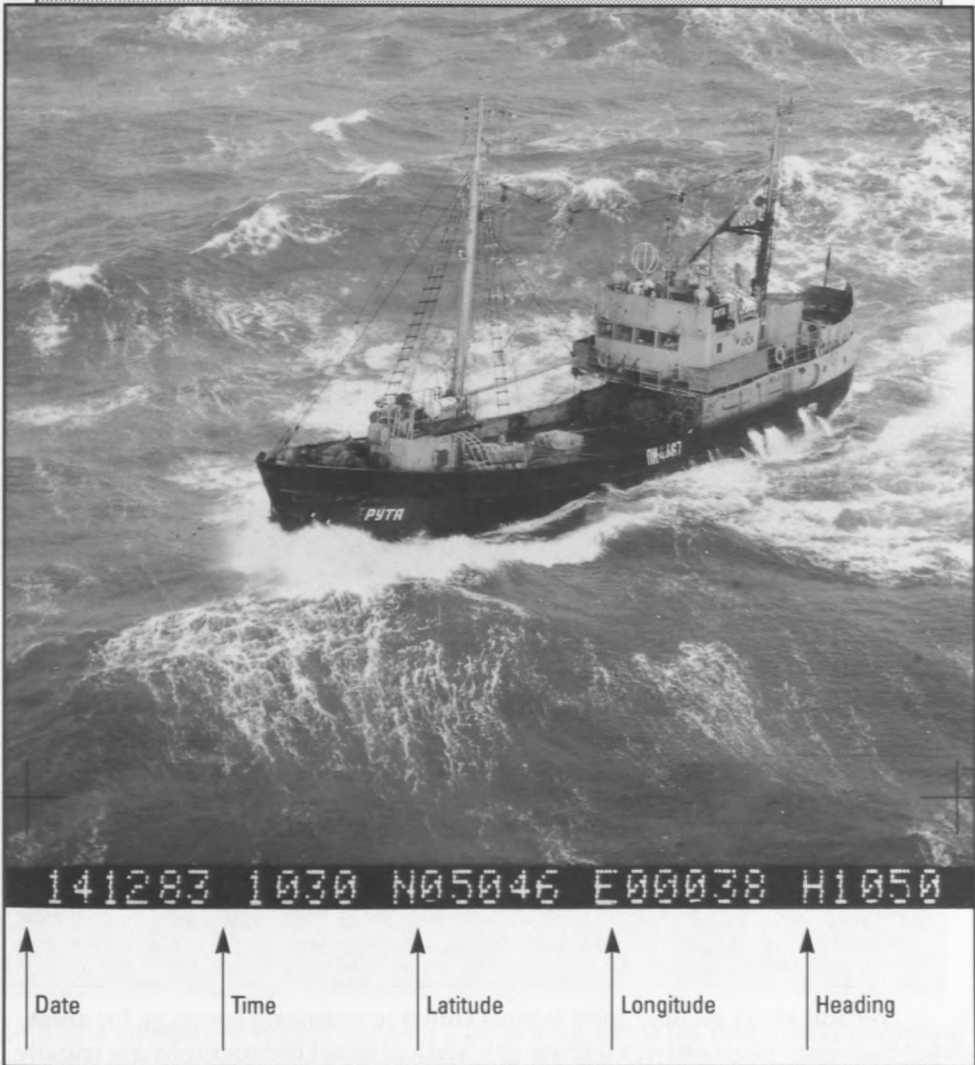


Figure 14 Hand-held Camera Systems Can Provide Oblique Photography with Very Fine Detail
