MORE MEETING PLACES

Toronto's diversity expresses itself in many forms, including the shopping experience. The area has many of Canada's largest, most modern shopping centres, the premier destination being the Eaton Centre. A 350-store, glass-roofed galleria, the Centre attracts more than 1.4 million people weekly. It's also part of Toronto's Underground City, 11 kilometres interconnecting more than 1,000 stores and services. This "hidden city", the largest of its kind in North America, stretches more than eight city blocks beneath the

downtown core. It also links major hotels, office towers, theatres and Toronto's fast, clean and efficient transit system.

But the city's most exclusive retail district is the Bloor-Yorkville area. The neighbourhood offers upscale shopping in a village-like atmosphere, full of pleasant courtyards, outdoor cafes and friendly people. Yorkville is home to the Festival of Festivals, a 10-day celebration in June of world cinema, with over 250 films attracting both the public and top industry people from around the globe. Toronto is indeed the "Meeting Place".
