

DECLARATIONS DEPOSITED BY CANADA
WITH ITS INSTRUMENT OF ACCESSION
TO THE UNITED NATIONS CONVENTION
ON CONTRACTS FOR THE
INTERNATIONAL SALE OF GOODS,
CONCLUDED AT VIENNA ON APRIL 11,
1980

The Government of Canada
declares, in accordance with
Article 93 of the Convention,
that the Convention will extend
to Alberta, British Columbia,
Manitoba, New Brunswick,
Newfoundland, Nova Scotia,
Ontario, Prince Edward Island
and the Northwest Territories;

the Government of Canada also
declares, in accordance with
Article 95 of the Convention,
that, with respect to British
Columbia, it will not be bound
by Article 1.1 b) of the
Convention.
