JEAN-LOUIS DELISLE

MR. DELISLE WAS BORN IN QUEBEC CITY IN 1912. HE WAS EDUCATED AT THE QUEBEC SEMINARY (BA), LAVAL UNIVERSITY (LL.L) AND RECEIVED A BA FROM OXFORD WHERE HE WAS A RHODES SCHOLAR. HE JOINED THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS IN 1942 AND SERVED ON THE STAFF OF THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE FROM 1942-46. HE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY POSTED TO RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL; BOSTON, U.S.A., AND FROM 1954-56 WAS CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. IN WARSAW, POLAND.

DURING THE ELEVENTH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, NOVEMBER, 1956 - MARCH, 1957, MR. DELISLE WAS ADVISER TO THE CANADIAN DELEGATION ON MATTERS OF TRUST TERRITORIES AND NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES.
