

ARTICLE X.—RESIGNATION.

Any member desiring to leave the Association shall notify the Recording Secretary in writing, and shall be liable to all dues till the date of such notice.

ARTICLE XI.—ARREARS.

No member shall be eligible to office, or entitled to vote at any election of officers, who is three months in arrears for monthly dues.

ARTICLE XII.—HONORARY MEMBERS.

Any gentleman subscribing Twenty Dollars or over to the funds of the Association, shall be entitled to the privilege of honorary membership. The Association may at any time elect honorary members by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast at any regular meeting, such members to be free from any payment to the funds.

Honorary members shall be entitled to all the privileges of the Association, except the franchise.

ARTICLE XIII.—CARDS AND LIQUORS.

Playing Cards and intoxicating liquors shall not be used in any buildings or rooms under the control of the Association, and it shall be the duty of the member of the Committee in charge to see that this article is rigidly enforced; and in case any member persist in violating it, after being notified, he shall move for his expulsion at the next regular meeting of the Association, which motion may be put to the meeting without being seconded.

Any member having been expelled for this cause, shall not be re-admitted within two years from the date of his expulsion.
