SEMINARY OF MONTREAL

This is the seigniorial residence of the "Gentlemen of the Seminary" - dates from 1681 - The chronometer is one of the oldest clocks in America.

Two old watch towers built in 1691 by M. de Belmont, a Sulpician Missionary at the "Mountain Fort". In the western tower Marguerite Bourgeoys taught the Indian children. In the eastern tower, which was used afterwards as a chapel, an Indian brave and his grandchild are buried. These towers still stand on Sherbrooke street, West, in the grounds of the Grand Seminary.
