

interment of each adult and a sum of two dollars for the interment of each child, as Burial fees.

IV. It shall be the duty of the person, having charge of the registration of deaths, to give to the party representing the deceased, a certificate of such registration, which shall indicate the number of the interment, the date, christian name and surname, occupation, age, payment or non payment of the interment fee and the kind of burial, which the ecclesiastical authorities shall have thought fit to allow and mention the refusal of an ecclesiastical burial when the ecclesiastical authorities have so decreed it.

Should the deceased have come to his death through any contagious or pestilential disease, mention thereof shall be made in the said certificate.

V. The *Fabrique* nevertheless shall cause to be interred gratuitously, in a common grave, the body of any person whose family is known to be too poor to pay the Burial fees or rates.

VI. The *Fabrique* may concede, in the said Cemetery, lots for the interment of members of the grantee's family, professing the Roman Catholic Re-
