

respective distances and take up their dressing with arms at "the recover." When dressed the Sergeant-Major will give the command, "Steady," when they will "shoulder."

(d). Buglers will sound "Fall in," when the men ^{Fall in.} will smartly and quietly move on to the parade ground with shouldered arms, and fall in at "the order," to the right of their Orderly Sergeants. Pioneers, Signallers', Band, and Stretcher Bearers will fall in as detailed in "Infantry Drill."

(e). The Sergeant-Major will give the command, ^{Dressing.} "Parade, Left, Dress," when the Orderly Sergeants will turn to the right, dress their Companies, and give the command, "Eyes front."

(f). When the Companies are dressed, the Ser- ^{Calling} ^{Rolls.} geant-Major will give the command, "Call your rolls," when the Orderly Sergeants will move to the front of their Companies and call their rolls. The senior Sergeant of each Company on parade will then open the ranks for inspection.

(g). Buglers will sound the "Officers' call," and ^{Officers.} Officers will join their Companies, the Adjutant taking over the parade from the Sergeant-Major.

(h). Officers will inspect their Companies as laid ^{Inspection.} down in *Infantry Drill*.

(i). During the inspection the Sergeant-Major will ^{Strength on} ^{Parade.} ascertain the strength on parade and report same to the Adjutant.

Officers of Companies broken up will be posted to ^{Posting} ^{Officers and} ^{Sergeants.} other Companies by the Adjutant; Sergeants, by the Sergeant-Major.

(j). Buglers will sound for Markers, who will take ^{Markers.} up the required distance for their Companies, under the superintendence of the Adjutant, and receive the commands from him, "Steady," "Order arms," "Stand at ease."
