Wheat Market Shows Strong Tone On Adverse Argentine Reports

Apprehension Over Damage to South American Crops Kept Trade On the Jump—Corn Higher.

CHICAGO, Nov. 20.—Damage reported throughout the entire wheat belt of the Argentine Republic, with losses counted serious in the important provinces, had a bullish effect to-day on traders in Chicago. The cereal closed all the way from Saturday night's prices, and 4-c to 4-c up. Corn advanced a net decline of 1-4 to 1-4 and 3-c, and unchanged to 1-16 advance and 3-c. The corn damage to wheat in the Argentine was alleged to have been inflicted by last week's storms, which were in some places said to have been more or less of hurricane character. According to one authority, the damage amounted to at least 10 per cent. Prices here made an immediate response and there was a further upward slide owing to word shipments being only about half as large as a year ago. In addition, the total quantity of wheat on ocean passage was reported as 12,000,000 bushels, less than the corresponding time last year.

However, the visible supply of wheat in the United States exhibited a decided increase, and there was a disposition in some quarters to discredit the stories of big damage in Argentina. The result was a reaction from the prices, but the closing tone nevertheless was steady. During the session, May ranged from 100 5/8 to 101 1-4 and 101 1-4 to 101 1-4, with last sales 1-2 to 1-4 higher at 101 1-4.

Corn and Oats Heavy. Prospects of larger receipts weakened corn despite early strength, due to the wheat bulge. Local speculators were the chief sellers, some of them unloading purchases made last week. May fluctuated between 64 1-2 and 65, closing 1-4 to 1-4 at 64 5/8. Cash grades were depressed. Concentrated buying did not have much in the way of hoisting. Top and bottom figures touched by the May option were 50 1-8 to 50 1-8, with the close 50 1-8, just the same as 18 hours before.

Hogs Plentiful. Hog products broke under packers' rule. An unexpectedly heavy run of hogs was given as the motive for the selling. Pork showed a net loss of 1-4 to 1-4, and the rest of the list varied from 1-4 to 1-4 to 1-4 decline.

GOOD CATTLE SCARCE MARKET 100 TO 250 LOWER

Lambs 25c Lower, Hogs 15c Lower, Sheep Easy, Calves Steady.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards, Nov. 20, 1911: 100 cattle, 100 hogs and 10 calves.

The quality of the bulk of the cattle was the worst ever placed on sale in the history of this market.

Quality of cattle was low, so were the prices in comparison with what they have been all fall.

Had there been some good quality cattle for export, the market would have sold readily, as Mr. E. L. Woodward, buyer for Swift & Co. had an order to fill of 100 car loads for the London Market, and as there were no cattle of London quality on the market he had to have the order cancelled.

Many of the dealers and dealers' staffs to the World's Fair cattle were off 50 per cent, but Mr. Woodward informed his firm that the cattle were off 25 per cent, to 30 per cent.

The top price for best butchers' cattle last Monday was 100 to 110 lbs. at \$10.00, which was 10c higher in this class a drop of 10c.

The heaviest decline was in rough undressed steers of good weights, which were hard hit.
