

LIABILITY FOR DON IMPROVEMENT. Unless Property Was Benefited, There's No Assessment.

The board of works met yesterday to consider the sewage disposal problem. The engineer understood that Toronto was going to get its water from the lake, and the dumping of sewage into it might be prohibited. They might solve the problem by putting the sewage through septic tanks before going into the lake. Dr. Sheard had his doubts about this plan. The only scheme on which he and the engineer concurred in any degree was a combination of bacteria beds and septic tanks to be situated south of Queen-street, between Knox-avenue and the Woodbine. The health officer and engineer will set up a scheme of agreement, secure the approval of the provincial board of health and then report.

Aid. Fleming and Stewart made strenuous objections to the assessment levied on property owners in connection with the cost of the Don Improvements. The engineer said that, from a sanitary standpoint the whole east end had been benefited, but Aid. Stewart said it was worse from that standpoint than before, and instances cases of people owning small homes, for whom the assessment simply meant ruin. City Surveyor Sankey said the bylaw had been registered against all of the property and while no charge would be registered against each lot, so as to warn intending purchasers of anything against the title, no charge could be made against any property unless it were benefited. In this particular it differed from any other local improvement bylaw. The report was passed on to council to be referred to the court of revision.
