BISHOPS' PASTORAL MAY SERVE GOOD PURPOSE, SAYS ORANGE LEADER

TORONTO, Feb. 5.—"If this letter would lead the French to learn the constitutional limitations of this lan-

guage, it will serve a good purpose," declared H. C. Hocken, editor of the Orange Sentinel, this morning, speaking of the pastoral on the bilingual question read in all the Roman Catholic churches yesterday. The letter urged obedience to "just laws," declared that regulation 17 had been subject to misunderstanding, and advocated sympathy on the part of the majority for the

minority. "I think I speak for all Orangemen," said Mr. Hocken. "When I say that we are as anxious to have harmonious relations established between the provinces as any class of men in the Dominion, but this harmony must rest on recognition of the constant right of the people of this province to determine the character of the schools that are being maintained by taxation."

WATERPROOF FOOTS ROUT "TRENCH FEET"

ST. JOHN, N.B., Feb. 5.—A number of wounded soldiers have reached here from England. Capt. Hamilton of Uxbridge, Ont., one of the returned men, was awarded

a military cross for gallantry on the battlefield. He was attached to a R.A.M.C. unit at Saloniki, and was one of the officers who assisted to drive back a large force of Bulgarians. Major C. E. Long of Ottawa, home on furlough after months with the 1st Contingent Ammunition Column in France, said that the Canadian boys were doing great work. Out of the entire first Canadian contingent only

twenty-seven men fell victims to typhoid. He said that there are no more "trench-feet," as the men are being supplied with long waterproof boots.

BRITISH FREIGHTER CALLS TO HALIFAX FOR AID

Several steamers and Government Craft on Way to Scene.

According to a wireless message received by Marine and Fisheries Agent Harvey here, immediate assistance was asked by the steamer, No. 2 hold of which was reported full of water. Within half an hour several steamers were on the way to the scene, on the Dominion Government steamer Lady Laurier was prepared to leave as soon as possible. The steamer in distress was bound here from New York
