

Romanoff Prince Reaches New York to Sell Rich Relics

HELPED TO SLAY MONK RASPUTIN

Russian Prince Arrives in New York; Admits Share in Killing.

HAS RICH JEWELS

Yousouppoff Carries Gems Worth Millions—Wife a Sister of Late Czar.

(By Canadian Press.)

New York, Nov. 24.—A tall handsome young man with an aristocratic delicacy of manner, Prince Yousouppoff, only male scion of the Romanoffs ever to set foot in the United States—arrived on the Berengaria.

He admitted that he had been a member of the party of Russian noblemen who late in December 1916 slew Gregory Rasputin, monk confessor of the late Czarina. He would relate no details of the killing beyond saying that Rasputin was lured to the Yousouppoff palace in Petrograd, slain and his body consigned to the icy waters of the Neva River.

He said he had come to the U. S. to sell some ancient snuff boxes and visit some friends and that he might attempt to regain two Rembrandt paintings given Joseph Widener, Philadelphia, as collateral for a loan. The prince had jewelry valued at more than \$1,000,000, some of them formerly the property of the Czarina.

The prince was accompanied by his wife, Princess Irene, a sister of the late Czar Nicholas.

10,000 POUNDS OF MEAT DESTROYED

The meat was in cold storage and the greater bulk of it was beef, pork, veal and mutton. This has all been destroyed and constitutes the second largest volume of meat stuffs to be condemned in the history of the local board. Last year a ten-ton lot was ordered destroyed.

She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Michael McGovern and has a sister here, Mrs. Arthur O'Brien, 289 St. James street. The boy was stealing a ride on an elevated car in Main street, Charlestown. In jumping off the rear of the car he was struck by an auto, driven by Henry Croker, who is a resident of Reading. The child was taken to the Relief Hospital and died of a fracture of the skull. The additional sad feature of this story is the fact that the husband and father died a short time ago, leaving Mrs. Kelly with ten children. With the loss of this little fellow, whose name was Henry J., Mrs. Kelly has still a family of nine to care for.
