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CHARGE HE LOST WIFE'S RICHES

Murray Spent Large Sums in Stock Speculation, Police Allege—Woman Says He Forged Her Name.

Boston, Jan. 29.—Mrs. Agnes Fiske Murray of the Hotel Memenway has charged the arrest of her husband, David Y. Murray, on a charge of forging her name to orders on a brokerage firm. It is alleged that Murray lost her entire fortune of several thousand dollars in market speculations. The warrant, which was issued on Mrs. Murray's complaint, charged that her name was forged to three orders on Parkman & Burr, brokers of 33 State street. The police say that with these two orders he obtained securities valued at \$14,450.28. His operations, they say, involved much more.

While the two counts in the warrant alleged that on Sept. 18, 1913, he forged an order for 32 shares of stocks, valued at \$9,183.35, and that on Feb. 14, 1919, he forged an order for 88 shares valued at \$4,466.83, the police believe there were later dealings, and that the amount involved will run well over \$100,000.

Mr. and Mrs. Murray have been living at the Hotel Memenway for several years. It could not be learned last night who is representing the husband, if anyone. He had not been bailed at 1 o'clock this morning, nor had he received any visitors.

Talking with officers who arrested him, Murray asserted his innocence and said he would later show that his arrest was a mistake. He did not deny that he is representing the husband, but he had not worked at his profession for some time, but said that as soon as the affair was straightened out, he intended to go to work at once. He had \$4 in his possession when arrested.

Everyone connected with the case declined to state in what manner Murray lost the money he is charged with stealing, but it is believed that most of it was lost in the stock market. At the time of the arrest the police say they had information which would have
