CHRISTENDOM'S JUST WAR

(Continued from preceding page) The next day, Sir E. Grey wrote as follows— His Majesty's government cannot for moment entertain the Chancellor's proposal that they should bind themselves to neutrality on such terms. What asks us in effect to engage to stand while French colonies are taken and none is beaten, so long as Germany does not take French territory as distinct from the colonies. From the moral point of view such a proposal is repulsive; for France without territory in Europe being taken over, could be so crushed as to lose position as a Great Power, and become subordinate to German policy.

When we turn to the generalities which the document contains about Germany and policy and plans, we find in vain for any reference to the changing of such writers as Treitschke and Bernhardi. Does it mean that those who have led the German appeal regard those writers and teachers as negligible, or that their own opposition to what those writers refer to in this general statement but we may be permitted to ask of what is within our personal knowledge. Peaceful and well-disposed in this country are being treated with all possible consideration and kindness, and the Home Secretary has them under his own protection. God knows what it means to us to be separated for a time by this great war from many with whom it will our privilege again—to work for the betterment of the Christian message among men.

Again we cannot pass in silence the tenets of the manifesto that "unbearable horrors have been committed since Germans living peacefully abroad." We do not know to what the historians refer in this general statement but we may be permitted to ask of what is within our personal knowledge. Peaceful and well-disposed in this country are being treated with all possible consideration and kindness, and the Home Secretary has them under his own protection. God knows what it means to us to be separated for a time by this great war from many with whom it will our privilege again—to work for the betterment of the Christian message among men.

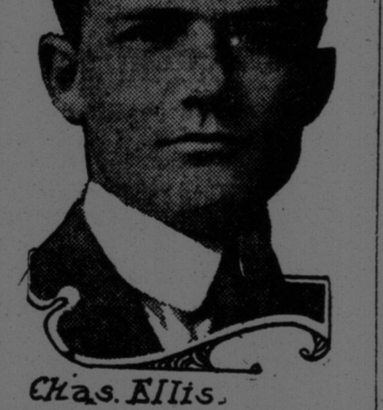
