According to a judgment of Mr. Justice Bakewell in the Madras High Court on April 15, Mrs. Besant has to deliver up to their father the two boys, Krishnamurti and Nityananda, for whom she claimed extraordinary powers. She brought ther to England two years ago. Mr. Justice Bakewell has made them wards of court until they reach the age of 21, and he expressed the view that the English would assist the Madras court in securing the return of the boys, who are in England.

In a report of the judgment the "Hindu" states that a Theosophic sub-organization, called the Order of the Star of the East, was formed with Krishuamurti, under the name of Alcyone, as its head. The boy was initiated into the mysteries of occultism by Mr. Leadbetter, whose principles, openly
