

The accused is of Jewish faith, and as the members of this faith are not very closely connected with soldiering, the accused went to great trouble to join the army, after having been turned down for medical reasons on two different occasions. Finally the accused found a unit who would accept him in view of his medical deficiencies, but after getting into the army he could not easily adapt himself to army life and the responsibilities of being a soldier, but the Defense stated he believed that had since been overcome. The sentence, taking into consideration the willingness and determination of the accused to join the army and also his inability to fully understand the seriousness of going A.M.T. The Court then adjourned for consideration of sentence.
