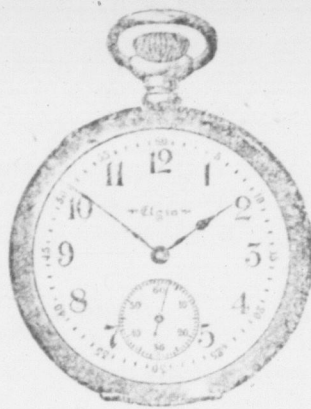

BIG LIQUOR CARGO

CONSIGNED TO BIGGAR

Some one at Biggar, Saskatche-
wan, is going to be very thirsty as
the result of the seizure by the
police of twelve barrels of finest
French liquors, Scotch whiskeys
and Canadian specialties at Winnipeg
on Friday. The barrels were labeled
"lubricating oil" and were con-
signed from Montreal to Biggar.

Another ten barrels and twelve
cases of liquor consigned as paint
and varnish to a non-existent com-
pany, "The Manitoba Builders In-
corporation," were also seized. The
liquor was seized by J. N. MacLean,
head of the liquor license depart-
ment for Manitoba.

The liquor shipped to Saskatche-
wan, designated as lubricating oil,
was detected by a truckman at the
freight sheds who said he was sure
they were not filled with oil as they
"did not come at you" when put-
ting them on the truck as barrels
filled with oil would. The railway
company refused to carry the ship-
ment any farther when it learned
that the barrels filled with sand to
make them the regulation 500 lbs.
in weight contained liquor.

ed through Berlin.

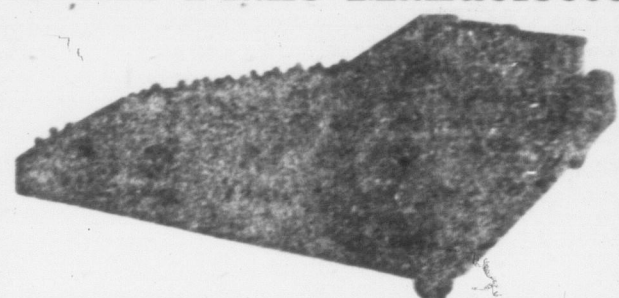
