An Act to amend the Act authorizing investigations in cases of accident by Fire.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the twen- Preamble. tieth year of Her Majesty's Reign, chapter thirty-six, intituled, "An Act to authorize investigations in cases of accident by Fire, and 20 V. c. 36. "to repeal the Act authorizing such investigations in the cities of 5 "Quebec and Montreal," and to extend the provisions of the said Act : Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. The duties imposed on the Coroner and the powers vested in him The snid Act by the said first mentioned Act, shall extend and shall be deemed to to apply to all apply and shall apply to all cities, towns, villages, parishes, townships, 10 subdivisions of parishes or townships and to all municipalities of cities, towns, villages, townships, parishes or places outside the parish limits, for all and every the purposes mentioned in the said Act and in this Act, anything to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. Such Coroners shall also be empowered in their discretion to Jury of not 15 summon a jury of not less than six persons to hear the evidence that less than six. may be adduced touching or concerning such fire, and to render a verdict under oath thereupon in accordance with the facts.

III. When any such enquiry shall have been held by the Coroner in Fees to the conformity with the Act first above mentioned and the present Act, the Coroner, and Coroner holding the same shall be entitled therefor to the sum of thirds, how to be paid 20 Coroner holding the same shall be entitled therefor to the sum of thirty dollars, if the enquiry extend to two days only, then to fifteen dollars for every day of the enquiry subsequent to the two first days, over and above his travelling expenses; And the official order of such Coroner for the same upon the Treasurer of the city, town, village, township, 25 parish and place without the limits of a parish, or of any municipality within the limits of which a fire shall occur and in which such inquiry shall be holden, shall be paid by the said Treasurer out of any funds he may then have in the Treasury, as he is hereby commanded to do, upon the presentation of such order.

IV. The third, sixth and seventh sections of the Act first above cited Sec. 3, 6 and 7 30 repealed. are hereby repealed.

V. The Coroner shall be empowered to summon to appear before Summoning him all persons required as witnesses in the matter of any inquiry held Witnesses. by him by virtue of and under the authority of the said Act and of 35 this Act.

VI. The District Coroners shall be ex-officio Justices of the Peace District Corowithout being required to possess the property qualification required ners to be Jusby any Act now in force in this Province.
