**7.** The Clerk of the County, in a book to be by him kept, shall record the divisions declared and appointed, and the times and places of holding the Courts, and the alterations from time to time made therein, and he shall forthwith transmit to the Governor a copy of the record.

**8.** The County Council shall from time to time appoint, and may at pleasure remove any clerk or bailiff. 5

Officers of Di-

**9.** Clerks and bailiffs, and other officers of Division Courts, shall not, during their terms of office as such, be qualified to be members or officers of any municipality or to vote at or directly or indirectly take any part in any parliamentary or municipal election, or to act as justices of the peace. 10

**10.** All persons holding offices as clerks or bailiffs, or other officers of Division Courts, at the time of the passing of this Act, shall continue to hold such offices until their successors are appointed under this Act, and may continue until the thirty-first day of December next, to hold also any municipal office and be deemed qualified to hold the same, notwithstanding the provisions of this Act to the contrary. 15
