- 17. All penalties and forseitures recoverable under this Act and The Liquor accruing to Her Majesty, shall be paid to the Receiver General of Inspection this Province, and form part of "The Liquor Inspection Fund."
- 18. With a view to meet the expenditure to be incurred under the venders of provisions of this Act, all venders or retailers of Liquor shall be bound, Pood and on the thirty-first day of December, of each year, to obtain a License Drink to under this Act, as such, from the Collector of inland revenue for the obtain District, which Licenses the said Collector is hereby authorized to grant licenses anon payment of the sum of five shillings, which shall be paid into the 10 "Liquor Inspection Fund."

19. It shall be the duty of the Inspector and Superintendent of Penalty on Police or other Chief Constable or Officer of Police in any locality to selling w.th-prepare and deliver, on the first day of March of each year, to such out a liceuse: Collector of inland revenue, a list alphabetically arranged, of all 15 venders or retailers of Liquirs, within the limits of his jurisdiction; and every such vender or retailer of Liquors continuing to vend and sell or expose for sale any Liquors without a License, under this Act, shall be liable to a penalty of fifty dollars for every day during which such person shall continue to vend or sell or expose for sale such Liquors.
