

Quebec 14<sup>th</sup> Feb 7 1828

Sir

I have to request that you will prepare and transmit to Lieut. Col. Napier at Montreal, a general Return of the Indians who have received Presents in Upper Canada, including Drummond Island, during the year 1827.

I do not require that the particular dates should be specified, (a detail which I possess on this point from Amherstburg, will answer my present purpose) but I wish the Return to shew the Number of Portions of Provisions issued in the whole & the number of each Tribe to whom the presents were issued.
