I am obliged to call your attention to matter of land purchased from Foster for the Indians some time ago I had foreseen what was likely to happen and ask you to try and prevent the same. You assured me that nothing of the kind would be done so I felt settled on the matter. Now I find my self hemmed in on two sides by I Andrews and if the ~~government~~ Government dont make a change in this matter I will be obliged to move out of my place. If it was a desirable piece of Wood land and near the Indian Reservation I would not feel justified in complaining strongly
