

~~When Douglas~~ having deserted him over two years ago, with no intention of returning; the Council think it well to remove her from the ~~List~~ of the Six Nations, and, her husband does not object.

3<sup>d</sup>. The Council, rather inconsistently, desired, that the illegitimate child of Isaac Bill be added, - to which I objected. The Council being inclined to again revive the question of repealing their judicious act of not recognising illegitimacy, - my suggestion to defer discussion was acted upon.

4<sup>th</sup>. In the <sup>alleged</sup> marriage, by John Statts and Christeen Carlou, the Council is not satisfied, and, if untrue, their child, will not be recognised as <sup>legally</sup> such.

5<sup>th</sup>. Some nine years ago, George Atkins left for Michigan, - it is said, flee from the consequences of some offence, and, has not ~~since~~ returned here:

His brother reports, some years ago, George married a White, and have since separated, still living in Michigan.

The Council, thought it well to remove ~~both~~ <sup>both</sup> from the list.

6<sup>th</sup>. Samuel Douglas, having behaved ill, the Council indicate its displeasure, by requiring him to return to his wife, and, reject the <sup>a</sup> reported child.
