
Appendix V - Canadian Duties, Edible Gelatine.


Dear Sirs:

After consultation with the Canadian
Ministers and the officers of the National Revenue Department
of Canada, the signatories are in accord with the suggestion
that the Empire rate on Edible Gelatine
be lowered from - 17½% to 10%
and that the lowest foreign rate
be lowered from - 42½% to 35%
and that the Australian and New Zealand rate
be lowered from - 12½% to 5%
and that Photographic Gelatine, which is Edible, should
be included within the classification of Edible
Gelatine at the above rates.

All of which is respectfully submitted.


