
Ottawa, May 3, 1907.

Dear Chief,-

In reply to your communication of the 27th ultimo, in regard to Indian Agent giving permission to white man to take timber off Indian Reserve, I beg to say that the Department is not aware of the specific case to which you refer, and if you will give the name of the party referred to, the matter will be looked into.

I may say that with the consent of the Band the Local Agent can be authorized to issue permits for the removal of timber in specified quantities.
