The relief schedule for this period was pretty much the same as for the preceding quarter, as there was no work available for the Indians, except the making of baskets, axe handles, for which little market exists at present, at least in this section of the country. In my last report I mentioned the small price the Indians were getting for their wares and upon suggestion from the Department, I wrote to Miss Kathleen Moodie of the Welfare & Training Service Department asking her to find a better market. I am still anxiously awaiting a reply, since the market here has not improved any. X Rev. E. Chiasson. Indian Agent.
