Following particulars supplied for background information.

(1) The assault is on A - 5 divisional front.

Landing of 7 divisions is to be completed by 1st tide of
D plus 1.

Initial objectives capture of Cherbourg and Caen.

- (2) Assault objectives are Force S Ouistreham Force J Courseulles Force G Asulles Force U Arreville Force I Saint Laurent Force B follows up Force O. Force L is following up Force for Eastern Task Force. Forces L and B sailed so as to unload on 2nd tide of D Day.
- (3) Assault Forces also include 7 Commandoes in Force J and 2 Ranger Battalions in Force O.
- (4) Bombardment Force consisted of 6 battleships
 2 Monitors 22 Cruisers 2 Gunboats 72 Fleet Destroyers 16
 Hunts. Capital ships grouped in 5 Forces. Majority of
 Destroyers accompanied assault Forces detaching to join
